- Based on National Civic League work
- Three hour dialogues - every 3 weeks - for one year – with 150 people
- Three areas of focus
- Creation of not-for-profit



Charge by the Board

- Way to measure community progress
- Chose Sustainability:
 - Whole system thinking and the importance of understanding linkages
 - Present and future thinking



Process for Selecting Indicators - *Legacy 2000*

- Original list of stakeholder indicators
- Met with knowledge brokers
- Forums around each sector to brainstorm
- Research national and local information
- Expert advice
- Selection

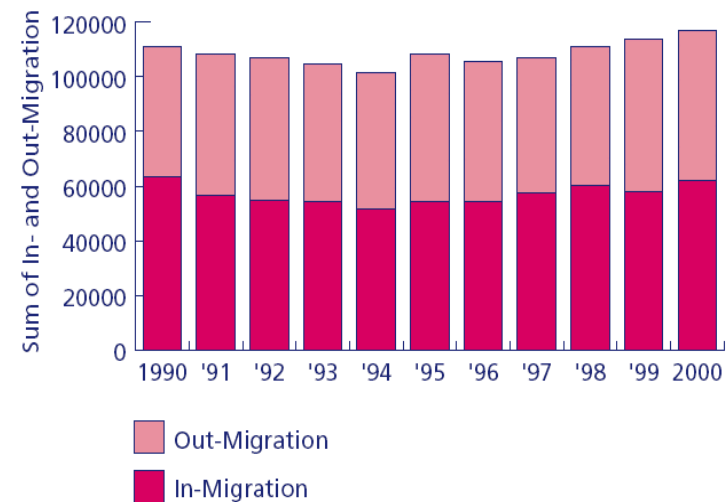

POPULATION "CHURN": TOTAL IN- AND OUT-MIGRATION IN

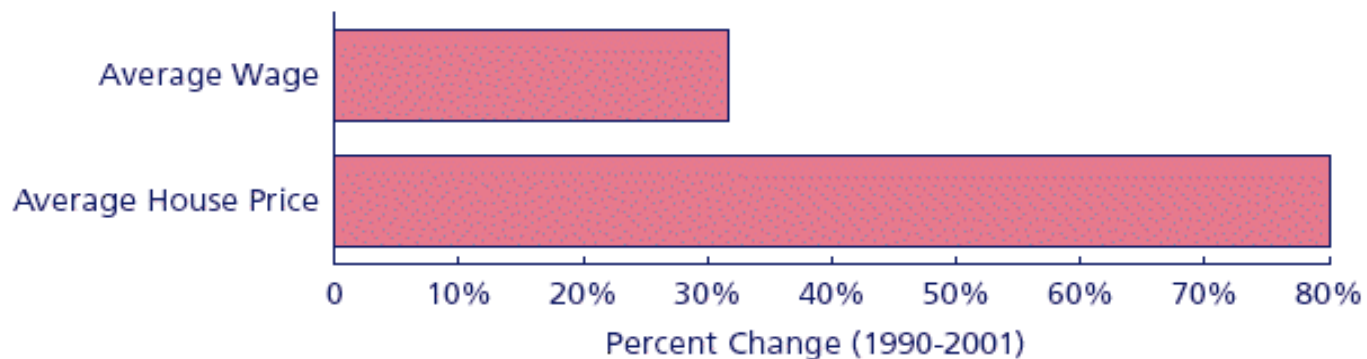

We're feeling "Economic Stress"

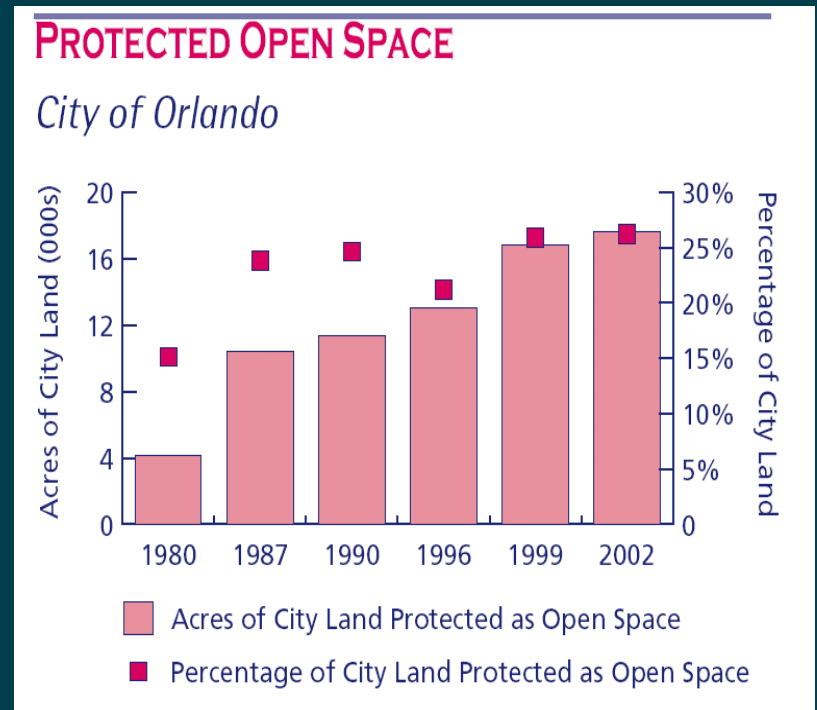
WAGES AND HOUSING PRICES IN

Orange County, FL



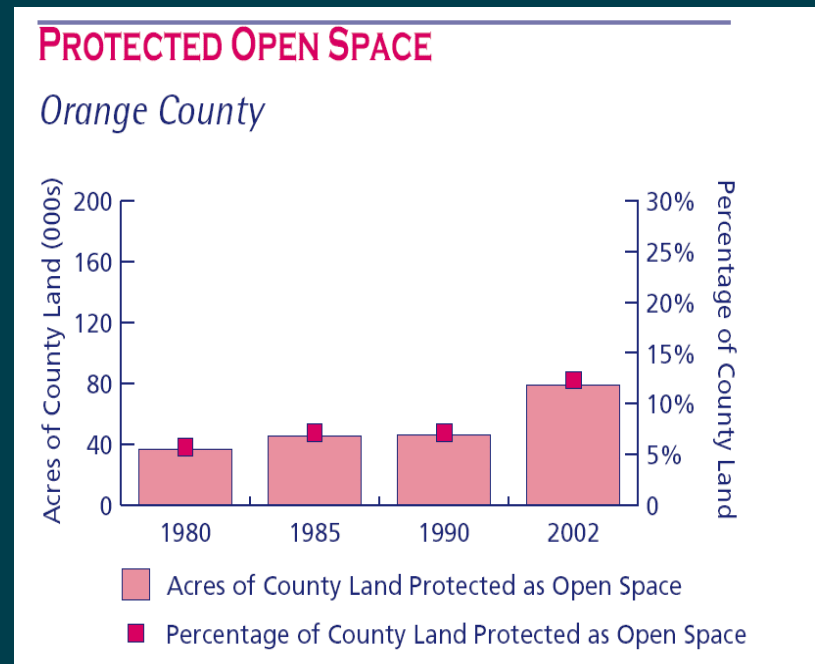
Open Space
